Essay Instructions:

- 2. Limit your essay to 500 words.
- 3. Use size 11 or 12 font in black ink.
- 4. Type it (double spaced) using a standard 8½ x 11 inch page format.
- 5. Center page numbers at the bottom of each page.

Do not include: Graphics, charts, pictures, school transcripts, letters of recommendation or other types of documents not specifically requested. These items are not evaluated and are disposed of if included.

Application Form:

The application form must be filled out completely. Exception: if the word "Undecided" is entered for the "Name of Institution" in Part III - Section B, the rest of the Section B fields may be left blank.

Type your information directly into the form. Be sure to proof your entry and save your file. Changes to your form will only be saved if you use the save command on the form tool bar!

If you must manually fill in the form use black or blue ink and legible handwriting.

Proof of Enrollment:
